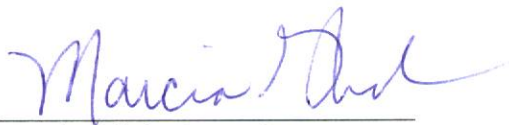


ROBBINSDALE CITY COUNCIL
WORKSESSION MINUTES
TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 21, 2017.
COMMUNITY MEETING ROOM
CITY HALL

1. The worksession was called to order by Mayor Pro-Tem Blonigan at 7:35 pm.
2. Councilmembers Present: Rogan, Selman, Backen, Mayor Murphy, Mayor Pro-Tem Blonigan;
Staff Present: City Manager Glick

REVIEW: 2017-18 GOALS

3. Glick reviewed a poster showing the Strategic Directions, Strategic Goals and sub-goals, and projects noting that the strategic goal: Timely Asset Replacement and Maintenance was missing from the chart.
4. Glick noted a number of projects that staff had identified as missing from the list. Council members confirmed additions to the list with the result shown in Attachment 1.
5. Council Members supported development of a Quasquicentennial Committee with 3 to 4 meetings in 2017, a plan for the April 19th event as well as summer events.
6. Council Members noted that it had been a while since the City Attorney had provided an update regarding the option of setting a rental density. Glick will make the request.
7. Council Members noted that the accessibility project for the library building would depend on the ability to get grant funding and donations. Glick noted that with the public safety building no longer staffed evenings and weekends, it makes the community meeting room less available. Council asked staff to explore what other options there may be to provide access to city meeting spaces after hours.
8. Council members noted continued concern about the park and ride facility. Glick noted that staff was involved in regular discussion with Blue Line and County staff with the expectation of options to be presented at the March 14th work session.
9. Glick confirmed that with the expectation of a city-survey in the fall, there would be need to get started. Council members expressed concern that a phone only survey would miss a lot of people. Council asked to get copies of sample questions other cities asked. Glick will target the April 4th work session for discussion on this item.
10. Mayor pro-tem Blonigan adjourned the work session at 8:47 pm.
