1. The work session was called to order by Mayor Pro Tem Blonigan 10:02 p.m.
2. Councilmembers Present: Rogan, Selman, Backen, Mayor Murphy Mayor Pro Tem Blonigan

13. Glick gave an update on water levels in Crystal Lake and pumping through Minneapolis. Minneapolis has hooked up a temporary pipe during construction to continue to allow pumping. Council discussed about possibly putting a park in the city owned open lot at the intersection of Lake Drive and Chowen due to high groundwater levels in the area.
