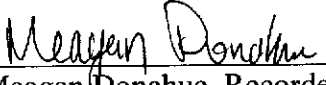
1. The work session was called to order by Mayor Pro Tem Rogan at 8:06 p.m.

3. Member Blonigan and Member Selman showed a photo presentation about their trip to the Rail-Volution Conference in Pittsburgh. Of particular interest was the East Liberty station area. They noted interactive displays by a stadium, color coded routes for busses, wayfinding examples, and shared bike lanes at moderate speeds.
4. Glick distributed documentation for a TOD project request for proposals which a county staff person, attending Railvolution had provided as an example, though not complete match, for the Robbinsdale station park and ride.
5. Glick noted that Bill Beard, developer of Birdtown Flats had complimented city staff as being easy to work with compared to other cities.
