DISCUSSION: Lee Park/3760 Lee – Water Treatment Site Options

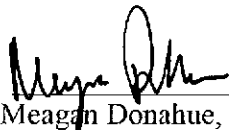
3. Glick noted that during the June 11 REDA meeting, residents asked whether there were other options for location of the new water treatment plant. An option to consider would be a land swap to expand park activities to the REDA property at the north end of the site and locating the plant at the south end of the park where there would be room for more screening.
4. Council indicated that they would not be opposed to exploring the option. Glick will set up a meeting with the residents of Lee Square and advise Council Member Selman of the date and time.

DISCUSSION: Potential Restaurant Development at 4153 W Broadway

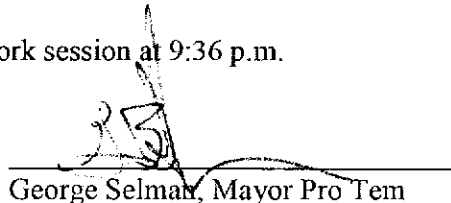
5. Murphy removed himself from conversation noting a conflict of interest.
