A. Insurance Renewal - Waiving The Statutory Tort Liability Limits

Summary: Annual renewal of insurance through the League of Minnesota Cities Insurance Trust. Staff recommended *not* waiving municipal tort liability limits and *not* purchasing additional coverage.

B. Sixth Amendment to Preliminary Development Agreement with 4orty 2wo Development, LLC.

Staff Presenter: Heather Rand, Community Development Director

Developer Attendees:

- Michael Opat (Robbinsdale resident, 4orty 2wo Development)
- Mike Maney, 4orty 2wo Development

Summary highlights: • This is a routine three-month extension of the agreement.

- Developer continues work on a high-density redevelopment proposed for the 4200 block of West Broadway

(approx. 200 units + commercial + structured parking).

- Pollution was found on-site; environmental assessment work is underway using secured state funds.
- Developer deposited \$10,000 escrow for additional due diligence performed by REDA.
- A blight study for TIF qualification is ~80% complete.
- Developer continues parcel purchase negotiations and project design preparation.

• Commissioners expressed support and appreciation for developer commitment to the redevelopment project.

Summary: Wicked Wort successfully met its 10 year business obligation related to a \$15,000 EDA loan issued for exterior building improvements. Staff requested approval to release the loan, and provide loan satisfaction documents.

Updates included:

Robbinsdale Low Income Home Improvement Grant Program

- Annual EDA contribution: ~\$50,000.
- For households under 100% HUD Area Median Income.
- One loan closed this year; five loans in process.
- Approximately \$30,000 in funds remain available.
- Program administered with the Center for Energy & Environment, often leveraging additional state/County Grants funds for projects.

Elevate Hennepin Small Business Support

- Assisted 14 Robbinsdale small businesses/entrepreneurs last year.

- Provides free and confidential consulting resources ranging from legal to marketing to loan packaging for entrepreneurs.

Downtown Business Façade Loan Program

- REDA was awarded a \$50,000 County grant; funds delayed due to County workload but expected to be available soon.

Commissioners expressed excitement for the program's launch.

Commissioners expressed appreciation for the update and validated the positive experience with the home improvement program

B. Potential Lease - 4614 41 1/2 Ave N
